WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Any student who is applying to Charlotte Latin School for the sixth through twelfth grade whose academic record places him or her in the top of his or her class may be considered for a scholarship. In addition, the family of a successful applicant must demonstrate financial need.

Scholarships are granted to top, motivated students on the basis of merit and financial need. These students must be excelling in their current schools.

TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Interested students must complete the standard Charlotte Latin admissions process, which includes testing, teacher recommendations, classroom visits, and submission of academic records. During the admissions process, parents or guardians will complete the financial aid process, and students will complete a scholarship application.

IMPORTANT ADMISSIONS APPLICATION DEADLINES:

- Complete an application for admission by January 15
- Register for the Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE) by January 15
- Return completed recommendations and a transcript to Charlotte Latin by February 1
- Schedule a school visit by February 12

IMPORTANT FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION DEADLINES:

- Complete the Parent Financial Statement (PFS) and submit it to Charlotte Latin and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS) by February 15
- Submit a copy of the parent's/guardian's 2009 IRS 1040 form with all schedules to Charlotte Latin by February 15

WHEN WILL I BE NOTIFIED?

Scholarships will be awarded in the spring. Letters notifying applicants that they have been selected will be mailed in April.
